

„1000\$” Competition Regulations

§ 1 General conditions

- The organizer of the "1000 \$" competition (hereinafter referred to as the "Competition") is REDDEERGAMES sp. Z o. O. with headquarters in Szczecin, ul. Zbożowa 4a lok. 2, 70-653 Szczecin, Poland, for which the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw in Warsaw, 12th Commercial Division of the National Court Register keeps registration files under the number KRS 0000351315, NIP: 7010226258, share capital PLN 187,500.00 (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer").
- The Organizer can be contacted by sending him a message to his Reddeergames profile on Facebook or via e-mail play@reddeergames.com.
- These regulations define the rules for the conduct of the Competition (hereinafter "Regulations").
- The Organizer of the Competition reserves the right to set the terms of the Competition in the scope not regulated in these Regulations.
- The competition begins on September 17, 2020 with the premiere of Cyber Protocol on PC and ends on December 31, 2020 at 23:59 GMT (hereinafter referred to as "Contest Time"). After the end of the Competition Period, the Organizer makes a decision as to the selection of the winners and then sends out the prizes.
- The aim of the competition is to promote the Cyber Protocol game and the Organizer.
- Taking part in the Competition is tantamount to accepting these Regulations.

§ 2 Rules and the course of the Competition

- Participation in the competition is open to all persons aged 18 or more, if required by the law of the country of residence of the participant.

The condition for participation in the Competition is the completion by the Competition participant of the following tasks during the Competition Period:

- purchase on the STEAM platform (<https://store.steampowered.com/>) of the Cyber Protocol computer game for PC (hereinafter referred to as the "Game");
 - launching the "TOP 20 Global Ranking" mode in the Game and starting the game in order to obtain the highest number of points in the Game;
 - subscribing to the Organiser's newsletter on the website www.reddeergames.com;
 - posting "I'm competing for the #highScore in Cyber Protocol game" in your personal Twitter profile;
- After the end of the Competition Period, the Organizer will select 3 Competition winners who will successively achieve the best score in the Game registered as part of the Competition. NOTE: at the time of saving the final score in the Game, the participant must be connected to the Internet on the device on which he / she played the Game.
 - The Organizer's decision is final and may not be appealed against.

§ 3 Awards

- The Organizer provided for 3 cash prizes in the Competition:
 - a) 1,000 US dollars for the person with the highest score in the Game in the Competition- 1st place prize,

b) 200 US dollars for the person who achieves the 2nd highest score in the Game in the Competition - 2nd place prize,

c) 100 US dollars for the person who achieves the 3rd highest results in the Game in the Competition - 3rd place prize.

- These awards may be reduced by the amount of taxes due in Poland. If the winner of the Competition's country of residence requires the payment of "withholding" taxes, the Competition winner will pay them on his own, unless this is contrary to local regulations.
- The Organizer reserves the right to exclude from the Competition persons who did not meet the Competition requirements. In this case, the excluded persons are treated as if they did not take part in the Competition. In case of doubt, the Organizer may require the participant to prove that he has met the requirements of the Competition.
- In the event of the winner's resignation from the award or failure to collect it, the Organizer reserves the right to indicate another participant of the Competition as the laureate, according to the order of scores in a Game registered as part of the Competition.
- The condition for the prize to be handed over is for the winner of the Competition to contact the Organizer in order to determine the terms of its transfer to the winner. The organizer will contact the winner either via Facebook or via the contact details provided by the winner on the Organizer's website. The organizer will contact the winner within 7 days from the end of the Competition Period. The condition for the transfer of the prize is to provide the Organizer with the data of the winner required by law and the bank account number in USD, along with the data necessary to make an international transfer. The organizer may refuse to hand over the prize in a manner other than bank money transfer.
- The organizer may make the awarding of the prize dependent on the handover of the laureate's official tax residence certificate.

§ 4 Final Provisions

1. The Organizer reserves the right to amend the Regulations and extend the Competition Duration at any time.
2. The Organizer of the Competition reserves the right to end the Competition at any time, without giving any reason and without selecting the winners.
3. Competition participants are not entitled to remuneration for participation.
4. In matters not regulated in the Competition, Polish law shall apply.
5. Any disputes arising from the implementation of the Competition will be heard by the Polish court having jurisdiction over the downtown district of Warsaw, Poland.
